TIME:

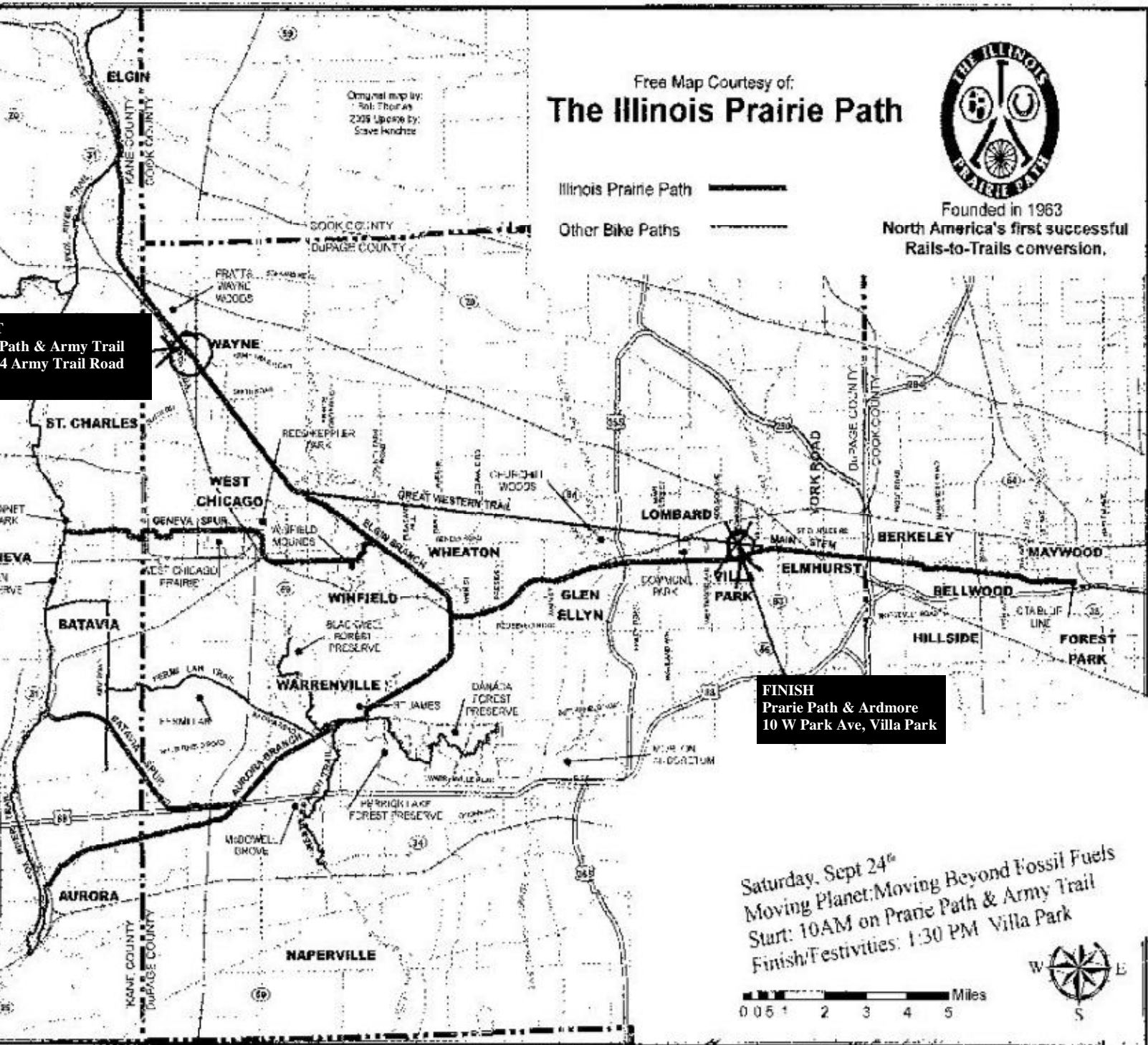
Elgin bike riders will meet & start at 10 AM at the Prairie Path at Army Trail
